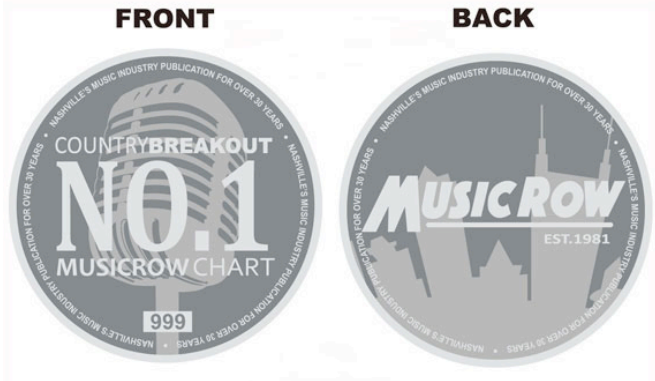

## NEWS

A new year calls for new traditions, and *MusicRow* announces its latest tradition, the **No. 1 Challenge Coin**. For those who are unfamiliar, challenge coins celebrate distinguished individuals, and the challenge coin tradition is believed to date back to WWI, when they were initially given to American soldiers.

Varying accounts exist, but the most common story behind the coin's name is as follows. After receiving a challenge coin, organization members carried it with them at all times. When *challenged* to prove membership, they would produce it to verify their membership status.



Although challenge coins carry a strong military background, they have been awarded to individuals in other spheres, including film, science and music. Each week, *MusicRow* will honor the industry's brightest players, awarding challenge coins to **artists** and **songwriters** who have earned a No. 1 song spot on *MusicRow's* CountryBreakout Chart beginning with the first *MusicRow* Chart in 2014.

We recommend that recipients carry the coin on their person at all times, should anyone challenge them to produce it. Each coin will be numbered, and appropriately displays Nashville's skyline on the back and a microphone on the front, marrying the industry's two most important players: Country and Music.

## SPIN ZONE

After spending 22 weeks on the chart, **Cole Swindell's** "Chillin' It" ices the competition, taking the No. 1 spot with 3,333 spins. Meanwhile, stations continue to guzzle **Luke Bryan's** "Drink A Beer," which jumps to No. 2. **Lady Antebellum's** "Compass" moves to No. 3, while **Dierks Bentley's** "I Hold On" rises to No. 4. **Scotty McCreery's** "See You Tonight" sees the top five, landing at No. 5. **Danielle Bradbery's** "The Heart of Dixie" lands at No. 6, **David Nail's** "Whatever She's Got" at No. 7 and **Jason Aldean's** "When She Says Baby" at No. 8. Earlier this week, Aldean announced a partnership between his upcoming *Burn It Down Tour* and Major League Baseball. Rounding out the top ten are **Craig Morgan's** "Wake Up Lovin' You" at No. 9 and **Josh Thompson's** "Cold Beer With Your Name On it," at No. 10.

**Blake Shelton's** "Doin' What She Likes" is the week's greatest gainer, racing from No. 68 to No. 27 with another 889 spins. Meanwhile, **Keith Urban's** "Cop Car" makes an impressive debut at No. 37 with 738 spins. **Eric Church's** "Give Me Back My Hometown" is close behind Urban, debuting at No. 45 with 677 spins, while **Brantley Gilbert's** "Bottoms Up" debuts at No. 54 with 451 spins. Finally, **Brad Paisley's** "The Mona Lisa" jumps 15 spots, ascending to No. 20 with 433 more spins.

## NO.1 SONG



One day after news broke that **Cole Swindell's** single "Chillin' It" sold Gold, the Warner Bros. singer/songwriter garnered his first No. 1 at the top of the *MusicRow* Chart with his debut title.

Starting out 2014, Swindell and co-writer **Shane Minor** will be the inaugural recipients of *MusicRow's* recently announced No.1 Challenge Coin, which honors songwriter and artist achievements on the leading secondary radio chart.

It wasn't long ago that Swindell started as **Luke Bryan's** merchandise rep, before his own career as a songwriter took off, leading to his current record deal. Fans have caught on quickly to the newcomer, who previously charted No. 35 as a songwriter for **Craig Campbell's** Bigger Picture single, "Outta My Head" and No. 31 as a songwriter for **Thomas Rhett's** "Get Me Some Of That."

Swindell's self-titled debut album is expected on Feb. 18. He continues performing with Bryan for the *That's My Kind of Night Tour*, after previously joining the *Dirt Road Diaries Tour* and *Farm Tour*.
