
SPIN ZONE

After only spending nine weeks on *MusicRow*'s chart, **Luke Bryan**'s "Drink A Beer" takes the No.1 spot with 3412 spins. Earlier this week, the singer <u>announced stadium dates</u> for 2014. **Lady Antebellum**'s "Compass" lands at No. 2, while **Dierks Bentley**'s "I Hold On" climbs to No. 3. Bentley recently <u>announced dates</u> for his *2014 Riser Tour*. **Scotty McCreery**'s "See You Tonight" jumps one spot, moving to No. 4, and **Cole Swindell**'s "Chillin' It" loses traction, falling to No. 5. Rounding out the top ten this week is **Danielle Bradbery**'s "The Heart of Dixie" at No. 6, **Jason Aldean**'s "When She Says Baby" at No. 7, **Craig Morgan**'s "Wake Up Lovin' You" at No. 8, **Josh Thompson**'s "Cold Beer With Your Name On It" at No. 9 and **Randy Houser**'s "Goodnight Kiss" at No. 10.

Rascal Flatt's "Rewind" is the greatest gainer this week, debuting at No. 41 with an impressive 684 spins. Eric Church's "Give Me Back My Hometown" rises to No. 30 with another 556 spins, while Keith Urban's "Cop Car" continues to arrest listeners, landing at No. 25 with 472 more spins. Urban is one of several Country artists slated to perform at the upcoming Grammy Awards. Finally, Blake Shelton's "Doin' What She Likes" leaps to No. 19 with an extra 451 spins, and Tim McGraw's "Looking For That Girl" debuts at No. 73 with 266 spins. McGraw will visit cities across the country for his 2014 Sundown Heaven Tour.

If you think **Luke Bryan** is only hip shakin' and partyin', there's a whole 'nother side he reveals in this week's *MusicRow* Chart No. 1, "Drink A Beer."

In November Bryan opened up about the song in interviews with the national press, revealing it is dedicated to his older brother Chris and sister Kelly, who passed unexpectedly in 1996 and 2007, respectively. Bryan's 2013 CMA Awards performance of the song written by Jim Beavers and Chris Stapleton was released as the <u>music video</u>. Stapleton, Bryan's Universal Music Group labelmate, played alongside the Nashville supernova during Country Music's Biggest Night.

Released as the third single from Bryan's blockbuster *Crash My Party* album, the song offers a rare glimpse into the heart of the Capitol Nashville singer—solid and grounded.

You can't get much hotter than Luke Bryan right now in Country Music. As of last week, the singer was No. 1 again on the sales charts, surpassing 1.5 million units sold.

His recent tour announcement rolled out quicker than expected when on-sale dates of the first tour leg flew off the shelf. Let's just say, be sure to catch a date on this upcoming *That's My Kinda Night* Tour – even if you caught Bryan's 2013 Spring Break, *Farm Tour*, or *Dirt Road Diaries* tours. This go-around, you may even catch him in a <u>ballpark</u>, or two.
