

Tell us about the road that took you to your current position? – While at the University of Florida I interned at several establishments inclusive of Entercom, ClearChannel and CMT. After moving to Nashville I was an extern with CRB and helped facilitate CRS 2014. The position with Sony Music



Nashville was listed and seemed to possess the duties and responsibilities that I have learned to love in this industry.

What is your favorite part of the job? - I love the ability to have conversations and work with stations all over the country. It is my goal to help foster a partnership with stations, providing an avenue to share new music and listen to feedback from not only the station but their listeners as well.

What is best about working the stations on the MusicRow Panel? –A majority of the stations take interest in new acts and take a chance on the single. Nothing makes me happier than the station end up making room for the add and then hearing about the calls and feedback they are getting.

Give an interesting fact about yourself that others probably don't know. – At 3 years old I recited my alphabet backwards to my parents and at 4 I told them I was moving away from Florida. At 22 I got my alphabet straight and moved to Nashville. Looks like it's time to set bigger goals!

What artists are going to make their name known this year? – I may be a little biased but we have some great artists emerging this year like Steven Lee Olsen, Josh Dorr, Logan Mize, and CAM to name a few.


