"This has been such an incredible year," said Swindell. "To have my first No. 1 song is incredible. I've always wanted to be an artist and to see my songs top the charts, so this means a lot. To get the first-ever MusicRow Challenge Coin is awesome."

Swindell's self-titled debut album will be released Feb. 18 on Warner Bros. Records.

SPIN ZONE

Top 10—After spending 11 weeks on MusicRow's Chart, **Jason Aldean**'s "When She Says Baby" takes the No. 1 spot with 3096 spins. Besides receiving an [ACM nomination](#) for Male Vocalist of the Year, Aldean recently announced that he will be joined by fellow nominee **Miranda Lambert** on his upcoming [Burn It Down Tour](#). **Scotty McCreery**'s "See You Tonight" jumps two spots, landing at No. 2. McCreery is one of many artists [scheduled to perform](#) at the "Team UMG at the Ryman" luncheon during CRS. **Danielle Bradbery**'s "The Heart of Dixie" moves to No. 3, while **Blake Shelton**'s "Doin' What She Likes" leaps to No. 4. Shelton [recently announced](#) plans to work with trio The Band Perry on the upcoming sixth season of *The Voice*. **Randy Houser**'s "Goodnight Kiss" climbs to No. 5. Rounding out the top ten this week is **Jerrod Niemann**'s "Drink To That All Night" at No. 6, **Craig Morgan**'s "Wake Up Lovin' You" at No. 7, **Josh Thompson**'s "Cold Beer With Your Name On It" at No. 8, **Justin Moore**'s "Lettin' The Night Roll" at No. 9 and **Dierks Bentley**'s "I Hold On" at No. 10. Bentley will [appear alongside](#) OneRepublic on an episode of *CMT Crossroads* in March.

Greatest Gainers—**Florida Georgia Line** and **Luke Bryan**'s "This Is How We Roll" is the greatest gainer this week, rising to No. 37 with another 394 spins. Meanwhile, **Eric Church**'s "Give Me Back My Hometown" moves to No. 15 with an extra 383 spins, and **Hunter Hayes**' "Invisible" debuts at No. 53 with 356 spins. Hayes is anything but invisible these days; he received a [CMA Triple Play Award](#) and is [featured on](#) Elton John's *Goodbye Yellow Brick Road* Deluxe Edition. (continued on page 4)...

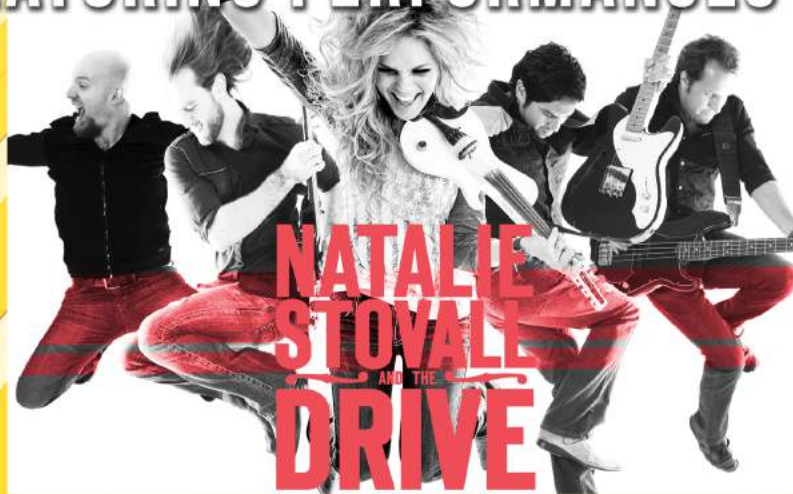

“When She Says Baby” is the third single from Jason Aldean’s Platinum selling album *Night Train* to reach the top of *MusicRow’s* CountryBreakout chart. The song was written by longtime compadres **Rhett Akins** and **Ben Hayslip**. Grammy nominated *Night Train* is the fifth Aldean project helmed by producer **Michael Knox**, and it also spawned hits with the title track and “Take A Little Ride.”

Aldean’s 2014 *Burn It Down Tour* will launch in May and plow through 50 cities and several baseball stadiums, with **Miranda Lambert**, **Florida Georgia Line**, and **Tyler Farr** in tow. “It’s no secret that I grew up dreaming of playing baseball stadiums,” said the Broken Bow artist. “I thought it would be as a first baseman, but playing them as a musician is just as sweet! We’re going to crank this thing up to 11…”

My goal is that when the last song is over, and you’re walking back to the parking lot, you’re already on your phone searching to find the next show.”

Aldean has sold over 8.5 million albums and notched 12 No. 1s at Country radio. The Macon, Ga. native is the reigning ACM Male Vocalist of The Year.
