Top Ten—Blake Shelton is back at the top of the MusicRow CountryBreakout Chart this week with "Lonely Eyes." Dierks Bentley jumps three spots with "Say You Do" landing at No. 2. Jake Owen's "What We Ain't Got" will sit tight at No. 3 again this week and Lady Antebellum will also stay put. "Freestyle" remains at No. 4 another week. Jason Aldean's "Just Gettin' Started" is starting its way to the top and is now at No. 5. Tyler Farr is again gaining traction on "A Guy Walks Into A Bar" as it moves to No. 6 followed by Easton Corbin's "Baby Be My Love Song" at No. 7. Cole Swindell's "Ain't Worth The Whiskey" is up to No. 8 and Eric Paslay has broke the top 10 with "She Don't Love You" coming in at No. 9. Josh Turner will spend another week at No. 10 with "Lay Low."

Greatest Gainers— Carrie Underwood had 351 new spins for "Little Toy Guns," making her the top gainer this week. Zac Brown Band's "Homegrown" is also up this week after 320 additional plays. Kenny Chesney continues the climb with 303 more spins than last week. Keith Urban with Eric Church is a popular combo, their duet "Raise 'Em Up" has 277 new plays this week. And A Thousand Horses' "Smoke" saw an increase spin count of 266.

Blake Shelton has taken another hit song to the top of The *MusicRow* Country Breakout Chart. "Lonely Tonight" is the No. 1 song for week 6 of 2015.

Shelton seems to do no wrong. Even when he asks a member of his wife's (Miranda Lambert) group The Pistol Annies to do a duet with him about a one-night stand.



Ashley Monroe is the female lead on the song and they debuted it together on <u>stage at the CMA Awards</u> last November. It became an instant hit and is nearing the 400k sales mark.

"Lonely Tonight" was written by **Brent Anderson** and **Ryan Hurd** and is featured on Shelton's *Bringing Back The Sunshine* album.

Shelton has been keeping very busy. Between tour dates, he is still a fan-favorite coach on NBC's *The Voice*, he recently hosted *Saturday Night Live* and co-headlined a show for the United Way of Metropolitan Dallas at AT&T Stadium with Usher. He is also set to reportedly play Arizona sheriff Wyatt Earp in the Western spoof, *Ridiculous 6*. It will be the first of four original movies Adam Sandler is producing exclusively for Netflix. And of course, he will team up with Luke Bryan to form "Bluke" and return to AT&T stadium to host the 50th Annual ACM Awards on Sunday, April 15.

How long have you been at the station? I am starting my 9th year at WIFE-FM.

How many "hats" do you wear every day? I am the PD and MD for three stations, morning show host. I voice track afternoons on the sister station.



What is your philosophy on new music?

Branch and Dean, Chris Weaver Band, Rachael Turner stand alongside Florida Georgia Line, Carrie Underwood and ZBB. Playing independents has helped us as we are No. 1 in our ADI.

What role do promoters play in your music decisions?

Promoters deliver news on how singles are doing in markets across the country and are the first to introduce us to new artists. The promoters also are invaluable in putting live shows together as they help get artist info and available times to us.

Why is it important to report to MusicRow?

We are the voice for secondary markets more music is bought in secondary markets than anywhere else. We also have helped launch careers, Florida Georgia Line and Clare Dunn come to mind.

Tell us something great about your station and/or city.

We are home to the state of Indiana's oldest county fair and first high school marching band. We also are in our 24th year of hosting a Country Showdown.


