**Top 10**— **Scotty McCreery** is certainly familiar with the old adage, "good things come to those who wait." After spending 40 weeks on *MusicRow's* Chart, McCreery's "See You Tonight" takes the No. 1 spot with 3077 spins. The singer tweeted his appreciation to *MusicRow* earlier today (see below).

Meanwhile, **Danielle Bradbery's** "The Heart of Dixie" moves up one spot, landing at No. 2. **Blake Shelton's** "Doin' What She Likes" jumps to No. 3, while **Randy Houser's** "Goodnight Kiss" leaps to No. 4. **Jerrod Niemann's** "Drink To That All Night" breaks the top 5, rising to No. 5. In less than a month, Niemann will perform alongside **The Swon Brothers** and **Dee Jay Silver** at the High Noon Adventure in Mexico. Rounding out the top ten this week is **Craig Morgan's** "Wake Up Lovin' You" at No. 6, **Josh Thompson's** "Cold Beer With Your Name On It" at No. 7, **Jason Aldean's** "When She Says Baby" at No. 8, **Justin Moore's** "Lettin' The Night Roll" at No. 9 and **Brad Paisley's** "The Mona Lisa" at No. 10.

**Greatest Gainers**— **Miranda Lambert's** "Automatic" is the greatest gainer this week, shooting from No. 72 to No. 33 with another whopping 876 spins. Meanwhile, **Florida Georgia Line** and **Luke Bryan's** "This Is How We Roll" moves to No. 31 with an extra 359 spins. The wildly successful artists will collaborate with one another at the ACM Awards in April. Shelton's "Doin' What She Likes" hits No. 3 with 237 more spins, while **Brantley Gilbert's** "Bottoms Up" advances to No. 24 (continued on page 3)...

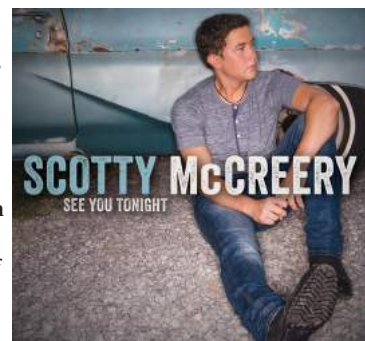

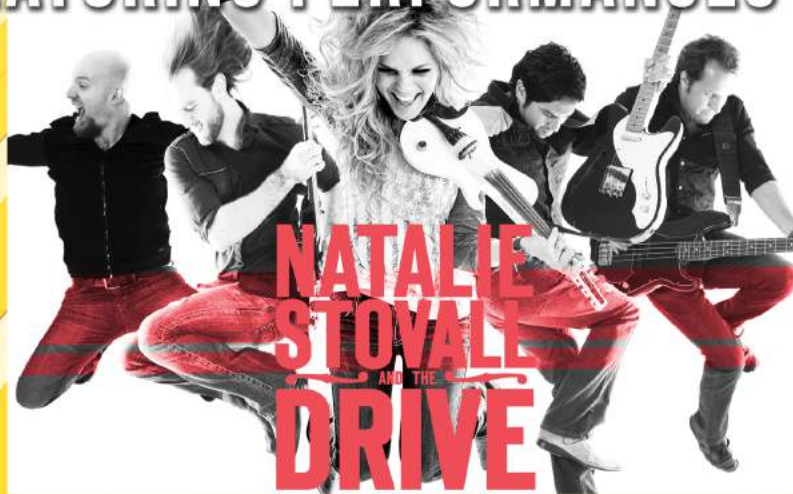
