### On The Cover — Sara Evans (Feb/March '14)

Multi-platinum selling Country singer and songwriter, **Sara Evans** has been called “one of the most compelling vocalists of her generation.” Evans will release her highly anticipated seventh studio album *Slow Me Down*, on March 11, 2014. The album comes over two years after the release of *Stronger*, her second *Billboard* Country Album Chart No. 1. After five No. 1 Country songs, *Slow Me Down's* title track, released earlier this Fall is her biggest first week Country radio added single ever and was recently named by *Billboard* as one of the “10 Best Country Singles of 2013.”

## SPIN ZONE

**Danielle Bradbery's** “The Heart of Dixie” has won the hearts of radio reporters, claiming the No. 1 position on *MusicRow's* Chart with 3104 spins. Meanwhile, **Blake Shelton's** “Doin’ What She Likes” climbs to No. 2. In addition to recently winning *MusicRow's* **Male Artist of the Year**, Shelton recently celebrated two No. 1s at Starstruck Entertainment in Nashville. **Randy Houser's** “Goodnight Kiss” jumps to No. 3, while **Jerrod Niemann's** “Drink To That All Night” buzzes to No. 4. **Craig Morgan's** “Wake Up Lovin’ You” moves up to No. 5. *CRS attendees* can watch Morgan perform during Black River Entertainment’s lunch at the Nashville Convention Center, tomorrow Feb. 21. Rounding out the top ten this week is **Josh Thompson's** “Cold Beer With Your Name On it” at No. 6, **Justin Moore's** “Lettin’ The Night Roll” at No. 7, **Eric Church's** “Give Me Back My Hometown” at No. 8, **Brad Paisley's** “The Mona Lisa” at No. 9 and **Sara Evans** “Slow Me Down” at No. 10.

**Greatest Gainers** — **Miranda Lambert**, who recently won *MusicRow's* Female Artist of the Year, is the greatest gainer with her single “Automatic” landing at No. 30 with another 224 spins. **Florida Georgia Line** and **Luke Bryan's** “This Is How We Roll” continues to climb the chart, rising to No. 26 with an extra 169 spins. **Hunter Hayes's** “Invisible” leaps to No. 38 with an additional 165 spins, while Church’s “Give Me Back My Hometown” breaks the top ten, hitting No. 8 with an added 160 spins. Finally, **Eli Young Band's** “Dust” ascends to No. 35 with 155 more spins.

## NO. 1 SONG

After rising for 29 weeks, **Danielle Bradbery's** "The Heart of Dixie" hits the top of *MusicRow's* Chart. The song is written by **Caitlyn Smith, Troy Verges** and **Brett James**. James, whose past credits include hits for **Carrie Underwood, Kenny Chesney** and **Martina McBride**, also produced the song. *MusicRow's* **Robert Oermann** reviewed Bradbery's debut single, writing "Bradbery's soprano has just enough fire and spunk to sell this thumping female-empowerment ditty."



Bradbery's fire doesn't show signs of dying out anytime soon. *The Voice* winner continues to rise in her Big Machine family, performing alongside a slew of big name acts during the label's *CRS After-Hours Show* earlier this week. The singer also certified her stardom by securing an endorsement deal with Sketchers and partnering with NBC in a promotional campaign for the *Winter Olympics*.

The singer's Nashville fan base can rejoice; she'll return to Music City in March to promote music education through her partnership with Give A Note Foundation and Disney Performing Arts.

Whenever a promoter can offer an in-studio visit, or special promotion associated with an artist, it's mutually beneficial for the artist, the promoter, and our station."
