

Don Williams, a member of the Country Music Hall of Fame, is retiring after six decades in the music industry. Williams was the CMA Male Vocalist of the Year in 1978 and "Tulsa Time" was the ACM Record of the Year for 1979. The Band Perry is no longer part of Big Machine Label Group, according to a statement issued by BMLG's Vice President of Publicity Jake Basden. The band released its full-length debut album in 2010 on Republic Nashville, a BMLG imprint. Their hits include "If I Die Young," "You Lie," "All Your Life," "Postcard



After 37 weeks on the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout chart, Lee Brice has finally reached the No. 1 spot with "That Don't Sound Like You."

The song was written by Brice along with Rhett Akins and one of the co-recipients of *MusicRow's* Songwriter of the Year, Ashley Gorley.

"That Don't Sound Like You" is the third consecutive No. 1 song off Brice's album, *I Don't Dance*. It follows the title track and "Drinking Class" as chart toppers.

Brice is currently headlining his <u>Life Off My Years tour</u> with Maddie & Tae and Dylan Scott as openers.
