**Top Ten** — After only 10 weeks on *MusicRow*'s Chart, **Eric Church**'s "Give Me Back My Hometown" takes the No. 1 position with 3022 spins this week. Church co-wrote the single with industry hit maker **Luke Laird**. Meanwhile, **Justin Moore**'s "Lettin' The Night Roll" climbs to No. 2, while **Brad Paisley**'s "The Mona Lisa" hangs at No. 3. **Keith Urban**'s "Cop Car" rolls to No. 4, and **Craig Morgan**'s "Wake Up Lovin' You" remains at No. 5. Rounding out the top ten this week is **Rascal Flatts**' "Rewind" at No. 6, **Sara Evans**' "Slow Me Down" at No. 7, **Brantley Gilbert**'s "Bottoms Up" at No. 8, **Thomas Rhett**'s "Get Me Some Of That" at No. 9 and **Little Big Town**'s "Sober" at No. 10.

**Greatest Gainers** — **The Band Perry**'s "Chainsaw" is the greatest gainer again, hitting No. 27 with another 329 spins. **Luke Bryan**'s "Play It Again" debuts at No. 54 with 311 spins. The singer recently landed at No. 8 on *Billboard*'s list of top "[Money Makers](#)" for 2013. **Miranda Lambert**'s "Automatic" rises to No. 11 with 240 extra spins, while **Florida Georgia Line** and **Luke Bryan**'s "This Is How We Roll" ascends to No. 13 with an extra 237 spins. Florida Georgia Line [recently partnered](#) with Big Machine Label Group and other organizations to combat hunger in the U.S. Finally, **The Swon Brothers**' "Later On" moves to No. 39 with 216 more spins.

**Debuts** — *MusicRow* welcomes debuts from five fantastic artists this week, with Bryan's "Play It Again" debuting at No. 54, **Levi Riggs**' "I'm Good" at No. 75, **Big & Rich**'s "Look At You" at No. 76, **Natalie Stovall and the Drive**'s "Baby Come On With It" at No. 79 and **Kacey Musgraves**' "Keep It To Yourself" at No. 80.

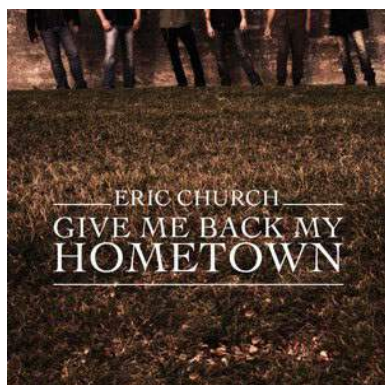

## NO. 1 SONG

**Eric Church** came up swinging with this second single from his latest album, *The Outsiders*, which moved a total of 288k units in its [first week](#), the largest Country release in six months. This week, the title track “Give Me Back My Hometown” has peaked on our *MusicRow* Chart, claiming the No. 1 spot.



Church has a way of inviting nostalgia into his music, and his co-written title with **Luke Laird** is no different. **Jay Joyce** masterfully builds an production masterpiece, which releases toward the end into a thunderous stomp, impactful and captivating.

You can catch Church in Austin, TX at the end of the month (March 29) for the inaugural [iHeart Radio Country Festival](#). In addition, Church seems to be playing every music festival this spring and summer, including Tortuga (April 12), Stagecoach (April 25), Bayou Country (May 25), Florida Country (June 14), Country Jam (June 21), Country Stampede (June 28), and the Cape Blanco Country Music Festival (August 2). In between, Church will join **George Strait** for the legend’s final *The Cowboy Rides Away Tour*, playing an acoustic set in Arlington, TX on June 7.
