Top Ten — After spending 22 weeks on *MusicRow*'s Chart, **Justin** Moore's "Lettin' The Night Roll" hits the No. 1 position with 3213 spins. Moore and fellow Country crooners Brett Eldredge and Kip Moore have earned ACM New Artist of the Year nominations, to be presented at the ACM Awards on Sunday, April 6. Meanwhile, Keith Urban's "Cop Car" drives to No. 2, and Rascal Flatts' "Rewind" moves to No. 3. Rascal Flatts will receive the prestigious Jim Reeves International Award at the ACM Awards. (Urban previously received the award). **Brantley Gilbert**'s "Bottoms Up" climbs to No. 4., and Sara Evans' "Slow Me Down" breaks the Top 5, landing at No. 5. Rounding out the Top 10 this week is **Eric** Church's "Give Me Back My Hometown" at No. 6, Thomas Rhett's "Get Me Some Of That" at No. 7, Miranda Lambert's "Automatic" at No. 8, Florida Georgia Line feat. Luke Bryan's "This Is How We Roll" at No. 9 and **Tyler Farr**'s "Whiskey In My Water" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers — Bryan's "Play It Again" is this week's greatest gainer again, leaping to No. 19, with another 573 spins.

The Band Perry's "Chainsaw" chops its way to No. 18, with an added 331 spins, while Craig Campbell's "Keep Them Kisses Comin" rises to No. 29, with an extra 257 spins. Lambert's "Automatic" shifts to No. 8 with 246 more spins. Finally, Cassadee Pope's "I Wish I Could Break Your Heart" ascends to No. 58, with 245 additional spins.

Debuts — *MusicRow* welcomes debuts from five talented artists this week, with **Cole Swindell**'s "Hope You Get Lonely Tonight" entering at No. 69, **Austin Webb**'s "Raise 'Em Up" at No. 75, **Rachel Holder**'s "Shining Now" at No. 76, **Brandy Clark**'s "Stripes" at No. 77 and **Steve Richard**'s "South Of Heaven" at No. 80.
