Top Ten — After spending 12 weeks on *MusicRow's* Chart, **Rascal Flatts'** "Rewind" fast forwards to No. 1, with 3171 spins. Flatts [recently revealed](#) the track listing to their upcoming album *Rewind*, set to hit shelves May 13. Meanwhile, **Keith Urban's** "Cop Car" hits the brakes at No. 2, while **Brantley Gilbert's** "Bottoms Up" moves to No. 3. **Sara Evans'** "Slow Me Down" climbs to No. 4. **Miranda Lambert's** "Automatic" breaks the top five, landing at No. 5. Rounding out the Top 10 this week is **Thomas Rett's** "Get Me Some Of That" at No. 6, **Florida Georgia Line and Luke Bryan's** "This Is How We Roll" at No. 7, **Tyler Farr's** "Whiskey In My Water" at No. 8, **Brett Eldredge's** "Beat Of The Music" at No. 9 and **George Strait's** "I Got A Car" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers — Bryan's "Play It Again" continues as the week's greatest gainer, rising to No. 12 with another 489 spins. **Cole Swindell's** "Hope You Get Lonely Tonight" moves to No. 48, with an added 271 spins, while **Brothers Osborne's** "Rum" debuts at No. 72 with 250 spins. **Eric Paslay's** "Song About A Girl" leaps to No. 25 with an additional 244 spins. Finally, Florida Georgia Line and Bryan's "This Is How We Roll" ascends to No. 7 with 241 more spins.

There's no need to rewind the clock to watch **Rascal Flatts** peak the charts with a No. 1 single, they're still doing it. This week marks the fifteenth time the trio has reached the peak of the charts.



Not only is the **Chris DeStefano**-, **Ashley Gorley**- and **Eric Paslay**-written single the first from of a forthcoming full-length release due out May 13, but the title is the first solely produced **Jay DeMarcus** and the band. For nine tracks compiling the *Rewind* Deluxe album, this will also be the case. **Howard Benson** produces most of the rest while Flatts' mainstay producer shares credit for two titles.

Leading up to their *Rewind Tour 2014* this May, Flatts will headline *Outnumber Hunger Live!* during this weekend's *ACM Party For A Cause Festival*.
