Creek Records and its artists to share


in revenue across Clear Channel's broadcast radio and iHeartRadio streaming stations.

Meanwhile, **Keith Urban**'s "Cop Car" hits the brakes at No. 2, while **Brantley Gilbert**'s "Bottoms Up" moves to No. 3. Sara Evans' "Slow Me Down" climbs to No. 4. Miranda Lambert's "Automatic" breaks the top five, landing at No. 5. Rounding out the Top 10 this week is Thomas Rett's "Get Me Some Of That" at No. 6, Florida Georgia Line and Luke Bryan's "This Is How We Roll" at No. 7, **Tyler Farr**'s "Whiskey In My Water" at No. 8, Brett Eldredge's "Beat Of The Music" at No. 9 and George Strait's "I Got A Car" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers — Bryan's "Play It Again" continues as the week's greatest gainer, rising to No. 12 with another 489 spins. Cole Swindell's "Hope You Get Lonely Tonight" moves to No. 48, with an added 271 spins, while **Brothers Osborne**'s "Rum" debuts at N0. 72 with 250 spins. Eric Paslay's "Song About A Girl" leaps to No. 25 with an additional 244 spins. Finally, Florida Georgia Line and Byran's "This Is How We Roll" ascends to No. 7 with 241 more spins.


