Her new CD project, *Stand Still With Me*, was produced by Ty Herndon and is receiving outstanding reviews. Released in August 2016, it also features Herndon on duet vocals. The album also includes three songs co-written by McAbee, including the title track. The first release "Looking Back to See" charted at No. 64 this year and Robert Oerman's review of "Journey On" states, "Be brave, hold your head high. Weather the storm. A better day is coming. This is a beautifully written expression of hope and inspiration. Play it."

Luke Combs has risen to the top of the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout chart for the first time with "Hurricane" taking the No. 1 position this week.

Sony Music Nashville and River House Artists [inked a joint venture deal by signing Combs](#) in October of last year. Columbia Nashville released the song to radio shortly thereafter.

"Hurricane" was written by Combs along with Taylor Phillips and Thomas Archer. It will be on Combs' debut album, [This One's For You](#). The release date is set for June 2, 2017.

Combs joins Brantley Gilbert on his eight-month Devil Don't Sleep Tour through September 2017.
