A Thousand Horses move up two spots to No. 2 with "Smoke." Kenny Chesney had a huge jump from No. 7 to No. 3 with "Wild Child." Eric Paslay is down one to No. 4 with "She Don't Love You." Miranda Lambert sits another week in her "Little Red Wagon" at No. 5. Tim McGraw remains at No. 6 with "Diamond Rings And Old Barstools." Carrie Underwood's "Little Toy Guns" is up to No. 7, followed by Brad Paisley's "Crushin' It" at No. 8. Kelsea Ballerini has broken the Top 10 with "Love Me Like You Mean It" reaching No. 9. Little Big Town's "Girl Crush" is up from

Greatest Gainers— Jason Aldean moves six spots with an increase of 376 spins for "Tonight Looks Good On You." Blake **Shelton** is cruising up with "Sangria" after 310 more plays. Toby Keith's "35 Mph Town" played 292 more times than last week and Kenny Chesney moves to the No. 3 spot, with "Wild Child" gaining 263 spins. **Thomas Rhett** has the highest debut thanks to 255 new plays for "Crash And Burn."

NO. 1 SONG

To say **Sam Hunt** has had a big year is an understatement. The sky seems to be the limit for the MCA Nashville recording artist who has already released his first studio album with No. 1 (song as an artist). To boot, he's co-wrote a few others, headlines his own tour and is nominated for ACM New Artist of The Year. This week his song, "Take Your Time," marks his



second No. 1 on the MusicRow CountryBreakout Chart.

The song was written by Hunt, **Josh Osborne**, and **Shane McAnally**. This writing trio also wrote Hunt's first chart-topper,
"Leave The Night On," which was one of the biggest songs of
2014.

The dramatic music video for "Take Your Time" has caused a lot of buzz as it takes on the issue of domestic violence. It has over 8.3 million views on VEVO.

Hunt's *Lipstick Graffiti tour* has been going strong since January and <u>will continue</u> through the summer until he joins **Hunter Hayes** on **Lady Antebellum**'s *Wheels Up Tour*.

If you prefer to gaze from your recliner, Hunt will not only be up for ACM New Artist Of The Year, but will join **Dwight Yoakam** the night before for a taping of the *ACM Presents: Superstar Duets*, set to air later in 2015.

MusicRow Spotlight

Jesse Stewart/PD-Mornings/KIAI/Mason City, Iowa

How long have you been at the station? Two Years

How many "hats" do you wear every day? PD, MD, Mornings, Farm Director, news, and sports play by play.

What is your philosophy on adding new music? I run a tight rotation so I can keep a good handle on my playlist. I have to be really picky with new music. My No. 1 thought is playing music that resonates with our listeners the most. A song could be testing well nationally but not so well locally. If I'm playing it, you know that I'm fully behind it.



What role do promoters play in your music decisions? It's always great to hear their thoughts and work with them to help break new artists. Even though I run a tight ship, I still try to help break artists that I really believe in. In the end, promoters bring me the new music and I can bring the best to my listeners!

Why is it important to report to *MusicRow*? Secondary radio is a vital testing ground for new artists and for new music. If you are not reporting to *MusicRow* then you are not doing those artists any favors.

Tell us something great about your station and/or city.Mason City and the entire North Iowa/Southern Minnesota community is a great place to live and work! KIAI and its 100,000-watt signal is just one part of our amazing five-station cluster that is one of the best in Iowa.

Who are some NEW artists that you're excited about? A Thousand Horses, Mickey Guyton, Brian Collins, Ricky Gunn, and Elizabeth Lyons.
