SPIN ZONE

Top Ten — **Keith Urban** locks up the No. 1 spot on our *MusicRow* CountryBreakout Chart this week with "Cop Car," which earned 3343 spins. **Sara Evans'** "Slow Be Down" accelerates to No. 2 with 3325 spins, while **Miranda Lambert's** "Automatic" gains 3275 spins, enough to park at No. 3 this week on the *MusicRow* chart. **Florida Georgia Line** and **Luke Bryan's** "This Is How We Roll" keeps rolling into the No. 4 spot, while **Thomas Rhett's** "Get Me Some of That" gets its first taste of the Top 5.

Bryan gets his second Top 10 entry this week with "Play It Again" at No. 6, followed by **Tyler Farr's** "Whiskey In My Water" at No. 7. **The Band Perry** cuts a wide swath in the Top 10 with "Chainsaw" landing at No. 8.

Another auto-related tune shows up in the Top 10 with **George Strait's** "I Got A Car" at No. 9. **Brett Eldredge's** "Beat Of The Music" hangs onto the Top 10 at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers — **Blake Shelton's** "My Eyes" is this week's greatest gainer, with 482 added spins. **Brad Paisley's** "River Bank" brings in an additional 429 spins, while stations played **Luke Bryan's** "Play It Again" an added 306 times. **Tim McGraw's** latest single, "Meanwhile, Back At Mama's," was well-received when he and wife **Faith Hill** debuted it during the 49th Annual Academy of Country Music Awards; it gains 304 spins this week. **The Band Perry's** "Chainsaw" ripped into the chart with an added 256 spins.

Debuts — **Dierks Bentley's** "Drunk On A Plane" flies up the chart to become the biggest debut this week at No. 67. Other top-shelf debuts include **Tim McGraw's** "Meanwhile, Back At Mama's" which comes in at No. 70, **Scotty McCreery's** "Feelin' It" at No. 72, **Deana Carter's** "Do Or Die" at No. 75, **Kayla Calabrese's** "This Is How It Feels" at No. 77 and **Lexi Larsen's** "You Can Leave (If You Want To)" at No. 80.

NO. 1 SONG

Have you seen the blue lights on the horizon? **Keith Urban**'s been on the loose with his latest single "Cop Car," which slides into the No. 1 spot on this week's *MusicRow* Chart.



Sam Hunt, Zach Crowell, and Kyle Jenkins wrote the title, which was released as the third single from Urban's 2013 album, *Fuse*. Robert K. Oermann [reviewed](#) the single at the end of January, noting: "Getting busted has never sounded more romantic. The left-of-center song totally charmed me, and Urban's performance gives it immense warmth and personality. A winner, for sure."

Other than his weekly *Idol* appearances, Urban's next tour stop is the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum's fifth annual *All for the Hall* benefit, which he started with the help of **Vince Gill**. The Nashville event will feature additional performances by **Brantley Gilbert, Brett Eldredge, Carrie Underwood, David Nail, Deana Carter, Kacey Musgraves, Kip Moore, Lee Ann Womack with Buddy Miller, Mary Chapin Carpenter, Reba McEntire and Ronnie Milsap**.
