Currington will no doubt include songs from his forthcoming album when he joins **Tim McGraw's** Shotgun Rider Tour this summer. The tour launches in Little Rock, Ark., on June 5 and includes a stop at Nashville's Bridgestone Arena on Aug. 15.






