Florida Georgia Line's and Luke Bryan's collaboration has moved one spot to No. 4 with "This is How We Roll." Luke appears again at No. 5 with "Play It Again." Tyler Farr continues his climb at No. 6 with "Whiskey in the Water." The Band Perry has moved "Chainsaw" up one spot to No. 7, followed by George Strait's "I Got A Car" at No. 8. Finishing up the Top 10 are Chris Young's "Who I Am With You" at No. 9 and Eli Young Band with "Dust" at No. 10.

## Greatest Gainers —

Tim McGraw was the greatest gainer this week, with "Meanwhile, Back at Mama's" garnering 493 additional spins. Blake Shelton was next with an added 396 spins for "My Eyes," followed by Dierks Bentley's "Drunk On A Plane" with 390 extra spins. Brad Paisley's new song "River Bank" moved up after 361 new spins, and Luke Bryan continues to move "Play It Again" with an increase of 264 spins.

#### Debuts —

Josh Thompson was the biggest debut this week with "Wanted Me Gone" coming in at No. 64. Zac Brown Band's "All Alright" debut is more than just all right at No. 69. Danielle Bradbury's "Young in America" bows at No. 71. Other notable debuts this week include Lonestar with "Just the Rain," Frankie Ballard's "Sunshine and Whiskey," Courtney Rau with "Click" and Leah Seawright's "Dixie Daughter.

# NO. 1 SONG

Songwriting team **Jimmy Robbins, Marv Green** and **Heather Morgan** teamed up for this week's CountryBreakout No. 1, "Slow Me Down," which was only boosted by production powerhouse **Mark Bright**, together with RCA Nashville star **Sara Evans**, herself.



This week, the title track off her March 11 release pulls ahead of label mate **Miranda Lambert** by 32 spins – a testament to Sony's ability to win with women. Not only did Evans' album debut at No. 2, but Evans will be crisscrossing the country in support of the project, including a visit to the Opry June 6 while in Nashville for CMA Fest (June 5-8).

One thing is certain, the 43-year-old mother of seven can pick a damn good song. Since 1997, the RCA Nashville star has churned out No. 1 after No. 1 at radio. So when she set her sights on releasing her second project in nearly 10 years, it was a sure bet airplay would follow.
