Finishing the Top 10 are George Strait's "I Got A Car" at No. 8, Eli Young Band with "Dust" at No. 9 and Jake Owen's "Beachin" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers — For the third consecutive week, Tim McGraw's "Meanwhile, Back at Mama's" has the greatest spin increase with 302 more spins. Blake Shelton saw 224 additional spins this week for "My Eyes." Zac Brown Band increased "All Alright" by 219 and Brad Paisley grew by 210 with "River Bank."

Debuts — **DOWNDAY** had the highest debut this week with "Crank It Up" coming in at No. 75. **Blair Matthews** broke into the chart with "It's About Us" at No. 78 and **Chelsea Bain's** "Cowboy in A Cadillac" at No. 80
