Top Ten — Luke Bryan is at the top again this week, this time it's his song "Play It Again" at No. 1. The Band Perry moves up to No. 2 with "Chainsaw" followed by Tyler Farr's "Whiskey In My Water" at No. 3. Chris Young climbs three spots with "Who I Am With You" at No. 4 and Eli Young Band with "Dust" at No. 5. Jake Owen jumps to No. 6 with "Beachin" with George Strait at No. 7 with "I Got A Car." Florida Georgia Line drops to No. 8 with "This Is How We Roll." Brad Paisley's "River Bank" and Blake Shelton's "My Eyes" both make the Top 10 at No. 9 and No. 10, respectively.

Greatest Gainers —Blake Shelton had the biggest gain this week. "My Eyes" received 316 more spins than last week. Lady Antebellum's new song "Bartender" followed with 281 spins in its debut week. Followed by Brantley Gilbert's "Small Town Throwdown," which entered the chart with 265 spins in the first week.

Hit songwriters Dallas Davidson and Ashley Gorley teamed up for the megastar's second No. 1 this year, third if you're counting last week's Florida Georgia Line single "This Is How We Roll," which features the hip-shaker singer.

Bryan's fourth single from the Crash My Party album has garnered sales of over 800k, with album sales closing in on 2 million units. No doubt about it, Luke Bryan is HOT HOT

The hit maker is currently touring the country through October on his That's My Kind of Night tour, in addition to having performances scheduled on the June 4 CMT Awards (June 4), for which he is nominated for five awards, as well as, both CMA Music Fest (June 5) and GMA's Summer Concert Series (Aug. 8).
