Brantley Gilbert's "One Hell Of An Amen" is at No. 5 followed by Eric Church's "Like A Wrecking Ball" at No. 6. Jason Aldean moves to No. 7 with "Tonight Looks Good On You." New to the Top 10 this week are Rascal Flatts' "Riot" at No. 8, Mickey Guyton's "Better Than You Left Me" at No. 9 and Kip Moore at No. 10 with "I'm To Blame."




(who co-wrote "River Bank"), and Lee Thomas Miller (co-writer of "Perfect Storm").
