Eli Young Band gains two spots with "Dust" hitting No. 4 and Brad Paisley also jumping two spots with "River Bank" at No. 5. Blake Shelton's "My Eyes" is at No. 6 with Eric Paslay right behind him at No. 7 with "Song About A Girl." Last week's top song "Chainsaw" by The Band Perry is at No. 8 this week. Finishing the top 10 is Swon Brothers' "Later On" at No. 9 and Joe Nichols at No. 10 with "Yeah."

Greatest Gainers — Lady Antebellum had the biggest gain this week with "Bartender" up 445 spins from last week. Eric Church's "Cold One" downed 416 more spins in its second week on the chart. Brantley Gilbert's "Small Town Throwdown" and Tim McGraw's "Meanwhile Back At Mama's" both had 331 additional spins. Dierks Bentley's "Drunk On A Plane" landed 262 more spins this week compared to last. Blake Shelton also saw a big jump in spins with "My Eyes" up 256 more than last week.

**Debuts** — **Breelan Angel** had the highest debut with "Double Standards" in at No. 76 this week. **Bucky Covington** buzzed onto the chart with "Buzzin" at No. 78. **Dan** + **Shay**'s song "Show You Off" made it in this week at No. 79.

# NO. 1 SONG

Tyler Farr's much more mellow single, "Whiskey in My Water," has distilled it's way through the MusicRow CountryBreakout Chart to land as this week's No. 1. Farr's previous single, "Redneck Crazy," mounted the chart in 2013.

Written by Jon Ozier, Phillip LaRue and Farr, the Columbia Nashville single is the fourth single from Farr's 2013 debut. MusicRow's Robert K. Oermann reviewed the single in October 2013, noting: "The follow-up single is a groovesoaked love song. As before, his singing voice is a raspy, soulful listening pleasure."

Farr is scheduled for appearances all the way until he joins Jason Aldean's Burn it Down tour next month (June 2014). Of those will be next week's (June 4) performance at the Nationwide Insurance stage at the CMT Music Awards.

In 1982, I began my radio career in Panama City, Florida under Skip Bishop. It was there, watching Skip, I learned the responsibility we have as programmers to play great songs. Sometimes those songs come from the majors, sometimes from a new artist with no label. To be fair to the music as a programmer, we need to listen without prejudice.

Promoters are key to reminding us to listen to new songs and

more importantly to go back and listen again. With the number of songs we receive from artists, labels, promoters, downloads and CDs, it's easy to miss one. Plus promoters can share the story of the artist or give me the nudge to "give it a try." In my busy week, an occasional "Have you heard?" can go a long way with me.
