Country P1s More Reliant on Broadcast Radio

A new report from **Edison Research** shows that Country Music P1 listeners are more interested in music via broadcast radio than outlets such as online radio or Pandora. Participants were asked to name the radio station they listen to most, each of which was individually coded by format. Country P1s were less likely than overall respondents to have listened to online radio, YouTube or Pandora in the last week.


