Mini Bio:

Raised in the small rural town of Kismet, Kansas, Mindy Miller grew up with wide, open spaces to dream big. "I was blessed to have parents who encouraged me to soar," says Mindy. Starting at the age of 3, Mindy was driven to perform using her God-given talent. Mindy continued to perform throughout her childhood and teenage years. She began singing competitively at age 15, appearing in statewide televised telethons and hosting pageants. She learned to play the piano and began writing music. Mindy enjoyed opening for Diamond Rio, Ty Herndon, Tracy Lawrence, David Kersh, Terri Clark, and John Berry at her local state fair. She graduated from Liberal High School with her sights set on Nashville and mainstream country radio. At 22, she signed with an independent country music label and went on to be nominated for the American Horizon Award and Best Female Singer of the Year at the 1999 Independent CMA Germany Awards. She was also featured in the May 1999 edition of *Country Music People* magazine. Mindy's 2014 country breakout album *Let It Burn* has already seen two singles; "Wrong" and "Coming Down on Me" make it into the Top 100 on the MusicRow CountryBreakout Chart. "Lie to Me" will be released to the MusicRow CountryBreakout Chart on June 13.
