Songwriters Receive No. 1 Challenge Coin



Top Ten— We have a "Girl Crush" on the No. 1 song this week by Little Big Town. Blake Shelton moves to No. 2 with "Sangria" and **Brantley Gilbert** is at No. 3 with "One Hell Of An Amen." Eric Church is up one to No. 4 with "Like A Wrecking Ball" followed by Jason Aldean's "Tonight Looks Good On You" at No. 5. **Kip Moore** skips to No. 6 with "I'm To Blame" while Rascal Flatts' "Riot" spends another week at No. 7. Mickey Guyton's "Better Than You Left Me" moves up to No. 8 while Michael Ray breaks the Top 10 and lands at No. 9 with "Kiss You In The Morning." Chase Rice remains at No. 10 with "Gonna Wanna Tonight."

Greatest Gainers— Luke Bryan's "Kick The Dust" kicked the spins up 481 times this week. Keith Urban broke into the chart after 463 new plays for "John Cougar John Deere John 3:16." 


NO. 1 SONG

"Girl Crush" was almost never written because songwriter Liz Rose didn't initially jump at Lori McKenna's idea for the song.

Once **Hillary Lindsey** blurted out the first verse in one draft, Rose became enamored.

When the girl-trio's song finally reached radio with **Little Big**



Rose, Lindsey and McKenna, together known as the songwriting collective "The Love Junkies," has enjoyed a 5-week run so far on other charts. This marks Hillary Lindsey's 4th *MusicRow* No. 1 song in less than a year.

Shortly after the song's release to radio, a *Washington Post* article reported that stations were heavily cutting back the airplay or dropping the song completely due to listener outrage over the assumed theme of the song. The <u>facts proved false</u> as *MusicRow* continued to see the song climb to the top.

Little Big Town will play LP Field Friday Night June 12 as part of the 2015 CMA Fest in Nashville and hopefully bring out a guest or two. So far, the tally of artists covering the song include **Taylor Swift**, **Kelly Clarkson**, **Eric Church** and **Erin Andrews** with the **Belmont Bellas**.
