Michael **Ray's** "Kiss You In The Morning" had a nice jump this week. He is up three spots to No. 6. Mickey Guyton continues her climb and now has "Better Than You Left Me" at No. 7. Rascal Flatts' "Riot" falls one spot to No. 8. Chase Rice's "Gonna Wanna Tonight" is at No. 9 and Lady Antebellum breaks into the top 10 with "Long Stretch Of Love" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers— **Keith Urban** had the highest gain with spins for "John Cougar, John Deere, John 3:16" up 625. Florida Georgia Line's "Anything Goes" jumps 342 spins and Sam **Hunt's** "House Party" is up 298. **Luke Bryan's** "Kick The Dust Up" has 292 new plays while Cam's "My Mistake" increases by 254.

Debuts— Jason Pritchett's "Good Show" has the top debut this week, landing at No. 71. Rick Monroe breaks into the chart at No. 72 with "Great Minds Drink Alike." Tyler Farr's "Withdrawals" debuts at No. 74. Also new to the chart this week are Dexter Robert's "Dream About Me" at No. 78, Allie Louise and "It's Getting Old" at No. 79 and Charee White's "Keepin' It Country" at No. 80.



Brantley Gilbert's latest album, Just As I Am, has now provided three consecutive No. 1 songs on the MusicRow

"Bottoms Up" and "Small Town Throwdown" both reached the top in 2014. And the third single "One Hell Of An Amen," is this week's No. 1 song.

and **Brian Davis**, the song speaks of losing a loved one. In the song, it uses a military family and losing a battle to cancer as examples. Both examples hit home with Gilbert. He lost a friend, Kory, to leukemia, and had a close friend who lost a military hero named Jon while fighting in Iraq.

"It's easy to say the song's about death, but to me, it's about the good fight," explains Brantley. "It's about the attitude, the strength and the courage those boys had for what they were going through. Kory battling leukemia and Jon fighting in Iraq... it's about two different wars. Anytime you go out fighting for your life or fighting for your country, that's 'One Hell of An Amen."
