Top Ten —Brad Paisley is the No 1 Song this week with "River Bank." Blake Shelton finds himself again at No. 2 with "My Eyes." Eli Young Band's "Dust" moves up one spot to No. 3 followed by Eric Paslay at No. 4 with "Song About A Girl." Tim McGraw's "Meanwhile, Back at Mama's" moves to the No. 5 spot. The Swon Brothers continue their climb with "Later On" at No. 6 and Lee Brice gaining two spots with "I Don't Dance" at No. 7. Finishing the top ten are Joe Nichols' "Yeah" at No. 8, Dierks Bentley at No. 9 with "Drunk On A Plane" and Easton Corbin's "Clockwork" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers — For the second week in a row, the Miranda Lambert & Carrie Underwood collaboration "Somethin' Bad" is the greatest gainer with 314 additional spins this week. Lee Brice saw "I Don't Dance" move two spots thanks to 281 more plays this week. Little Big Town's "Day Drinking" had 248 more spins to move it into the Top 40. Rascal Flatts' "Payback" gained 12 spots after 219 additional spins. And the 206 more spins on Dierks Bentley's "Drunk On A Plane" helped move him up the Top 10.

Debuts - Keith Urban's "Somewhere In My Car" was the highest debut this week, breaking in at No. 75. **Stephanie Quayle** finds herself on the chart for the first time with "Sugar High" at No. 77. Also debuting this week is **Craig Morrison**'s "Phone Call" at No. 78 and **Jill & Julia**'s "Wildfire" at No. 80.




NO. 1 SONG



Tell us about your station

KBOE is a locally owned radio station in southeast Iowa. We're 50,000 watts of hot country hits! We also carry NASCAR, the Iowa Hawkeyes football and basketball, our local university - William Penn football and basketball, and our very own Oskaloosa Indians sports teams.

What is your Playlist Mindset?

If you're on my playlist, you're a pretty good song, and you're doing well on the charts. KBOE has a daily New Music Challenge that I use to test out every song before it goes on my playlist. I've



had some total unknowns come out of nowhere to win 5 in a row and get an automatic spot on my playlist. Every once in a while, if a song really grabs my attention, I will go with my gut and add it early.

Why is it important to report to MusicRow?

It gives us a sense of pride belonging to a group of some of the best smaller market stations in the country! It's great to talk to the record promoters on a weekly basis and to have access to most of the major record labels, whether it be giveaways, interviews, etc..

Who are some of your favorite New Artists?

Newer artists that excite me are The Cadillac Three, Clare Dunn, and Chris Weaver Band.
