Top Ten—Blake Shelton continues his streak of No. 1 songs as "Sangria" hits the top this week. Jason Aldean moves into position to possibly take that spot next week with "Tonight Looks Good On You" at No. 2. Eric Church remains at No. 3 with "Like A Wrecking Ball." Michael Ray's "Kiss You In The Morning" moves up two and is at No. 4 followed by Kip Moore's "I'm To Blame" at No. 5. Mickey Guyton is up one spot to No. 6 with "Better Than You Left Me." Chase Rice continues his long climb as "Gonna Wanna Tonight" is up to No. 7, with Lady Antebellum's "Long Stretch Of Love" right behind at No. 8. New the Top 10 are Frankie Ballard's "Young & Crazy" at No. 9 and Luke Bryan's "Kick The Dust Up" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers— Kenny Chesney's "Save It For A Rainy Day" was the top gainer this week with 415 spins in the first week. Keith Urban's "John Cougar, John Deere, John 3:16" moved up the chart after 354 additional plays. Florida Georgia Line received an upsurge of 349 spins for "Anything Goes." Sam Hunt's "House Party" is at No. 16 thanks to 327 more plays this week and Miranda Lambert's "Smokin' And Drinkin'" is now Top 40 after being played 297 more times.

**Debuts—Kenny Chesney** had a huge debut this week with "Save It For A Rainy Day" landing at No. 47. **Dierks Bentley** is on the chart with "Riser" at No. 69. **The Cadillac Three** debuts at No. 73 with "White Lightning" and **John Anderson's** "I Work A Little Better" at No. 74. Also new to the chart are **Sara Dunn Band** at No. 77 with "Bye Bye," **Jana Kramer's** "I Got The Boy" at No. 78, "Just Two Kids" by **Tyler Bar ham** at No. 79 and **Clare Dunn's** "Move On" at No. 80.

Blake Shelton continues his streak of No. 1 songs with "Sangria," his sixth in a row to top the MusicRow CountryBreakout Chart.

Released as the third single from his ninth studio album, *Bringing Back The Sunshine*, the song was penned by hit writers **JT Harding**, **Josh Osborne**, and **Trevor** 



**Rosen**. Harding had a No. 1 with Keith Urban's "Somewhere In My Car" last year. This is the third No. 1 song for Osborne this year and the second for Rosen.

Shelton says "Sangria" is one of the sexiest songs he's ever cut. And it translates into the <u>steamy video</u> that has over 7 million views on YouTube.

Shelton stays busy with his coaching duties on NBC's *The Voice*, but he will also star in **Adam Sandler's** film *The Ridiculous 6* which will be released exclusively to Netflix this year. In addition to all of these TV and film appearances, Shelton will continue to tour this summer hitting several fairs and festivals across the country.
