Top Ten — This week's No. 1 Song is "My Eyes" by Blake Shelton, followed by Eli Young Band's "Dust" at No. 2. Also moving up the chart is Eric Paslay's "Song About A Girl" at No. 3 and Tim McGraw's "Meanwhile, Back at Mama's" at No. 4. Lee Brice climbs into the Top 5 with "I Don't Dance." The Swon Brothers remain at No. 6 for another week with "Later On." Dierks Bentley moves "Drunk On A Plane" to No. 7 and Joe Nichols' "Yeah" remains at No. 8 for another week. Finishing the Top 10 are Easton Corbin's "Clockwork" at No. 9 and last week's No. 1, "River Bank" by Brad Paisley at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers —Kenny Chesney's new song "American Kids" had the largest spin increase with 970 new spins this week. Keith Urban also moved "Somewhere In My Car" up the chart with 332 additional spins. Miranda Lambert and Carrie Underwood's "Somethin' Bad" gained 253 additional spins, and Sam Hunt's new song "Leave The Night On" saw an increase of 224. And Little Big Town also gained two spots, with "Day Drinking" receiving a spin increase of 212.

**Debuts - Kenny Chesney** had the highest debut this week with "American Kids" debuting at No. 39. **Sam Hunt**'s new song "Leave The Night On" breaks into the chart at No. 65 and **LiveWire**'s "Drivin' You Outta My Mind" comes in at No. 78.
