Also new to the Top 10 is **Thomas Rhett**, whose "Crash And Burn" moves to No. 10.

Greatest Gainers—**Kenny Chesney's** "Save It For A Rainy Day" has this week's biggest spin gain with 423. **Keith Urban's** "John Cougar John Deere John 3:16" gets 377 more and **Luke Bryan's** "Kick The Dust Up" is up 366. **Miranda Lambert's** "Smokin' And Drinkin'" moves up 312 spins and **Dierks' "Riser"** is up 291.

NO. 1 SONG

It took 16 short weeks to move another **Jason Aldean** hit to the top spot. "Tonight Looks Good On You" is the No. 1 song on *MusicRow's* CountryBreakout Chart this week.

This is the third single from Aldean's platinum-certified album *Old Boots, New Dirt*. the Michael Knox-produced work previously charted "Burnin' It Down" and "Just Getting' Started."

"Tonight Looks Good On You" was written by **Ashley Gorley** and Peach Picker members **Dallas Davidson** and **Rhett Akins**. This is Gorley's fourth No. 1 song of 2015. He was also a co-writer on Aldean's "Just Getting' Started," as was Akins. This is Davidson's first No. 1 of 2015.
