Top Ten— Jason Aldean looks good at No. 1 with "Tonight Looks Good On You." Eric Church preps for spot at the top after "Like A Wrecking Ball" moves to No. 2 this week. Michael Ray's "Kiss You In The Morning" is up one to No. 3. Kip Moore is at No. 4 with "I'm To Blame" followed by Mickey Guyton's "Better Than You Left Me" at No. 5. Luke Bryan jumps 4 spots to No. 6 with "Kick The Dust Up." Lady **Antebellum** moves to No. 7 with "Long Stretch Of Love." Chase Rice drops one spot to No. 8 with "Gonna Wanna Tonight." Zac Brown Band jumps into the top 10 with "Loving You Easy" at No. 9. Also new to the Top 10 is **Thomas** Rhett, whose "Crash And Burn" moves to No. 10.

Greatest Gainers—Kenny Chesney's "Save It For A Rainy Day" has this week's biggest spin gain with 423. Keith **Urban's** "John Cougar John Deere John 3:16" gets 377 more and Luke Bryan's "Kick The Dust Up" is up 366. Miranda Lambert's "Smokin' And Drinkin'" moves up 312 spins and Dierks' "Riser" is up 291.

Debuts— Alan Jackson has the highest debut with "Jim And Jack And Hank" landing at No. 68. Vince Hatfield's "How Long Will I Love You" shows up at No. 73 followed by Brian **Collins'** debut for "Shine A Little Love" at No. 74. **The Cains** are here with "Journey's End" at No. 76. Also new to the chart are **Craig Campbell's** "Tomorrow Tonight" at No. 78, **Sherry** Lynn at No. 79 with "What Are You Running From," and Sammy Hakin's "Empty Bottle" at No. 80


