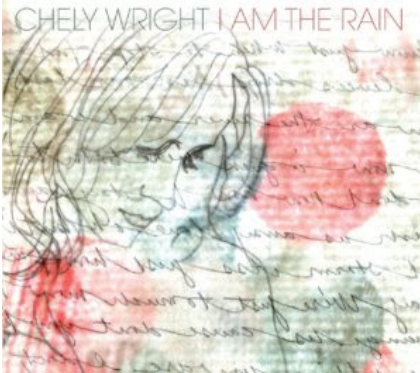
Kenny Chesney Moves Album Release To October

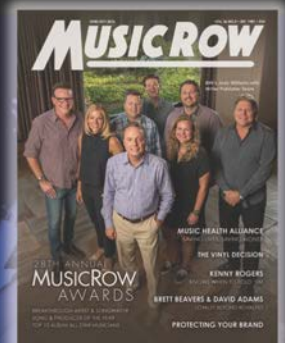
