Kip Moore's "I'm To Blame" is at No. 3 followed by **Luke Bryan's** "Kick The Dust Up" at No. 4. Lady Antebellum jumps two spots with "Long Stretch Of Love" landing at No. 5. Mickey Guyton drops to No. 6 with "Better Than You Left Me." **Chase Rice** hangs in there another week and moves to No. 7 with "Gonna Wanna Tonight." Zac **Brown Band** is up one to No. 8 with "Loving You Easy," followed by Thomas Rhett's "Crash And Burn" at No. 9. **Maddie And Tae** break the top ten with "Fly" at No. 10.


