Top Ten— **Eric Church** slams into the No. 1 spot this week with “Like A Wrecking Ball.” **Michael Ray** moves up to No. 2 with “Kiss You In The Morning.” **Kip Moore’s** “I’m To Blame” is at No. 3 followed by **Luke Bryan’s** “Kick The Dust Up” at No. 4. **Lady Antebellum** jumps two spots with “Long Stretch Of Love” landing at No. 5. **Mickey Guyton** drops to No. 6 with “Better Than You Left Me.” **Chase Rice** hangs in there another week and moves to No. 7 with “Gonna Wanna Tonight.” **Zac Brown Band** is up one to No. 8 with “Loving You Easy,” followed by **Thomas Rhett’s** “Crash And Burn” at No. 9. **Maddie And Tae** break the top ten with “Fly” at No. 10.

Greatest Spin Gainers— **Cam** had a big first week with 375 spins of “Burning House.” **Florida Georgia Line’s** “Anything Goes” grabs 364 plays and **Keith Urban’s** “John Cougar John Deere John 3:16” is up 303. **Sam Hunt’s** “House Party” continues the climb with 297 additional spins and **Dierks’** “Riser” continues to...Rise (pun). The song gained 295 more plays this week.

Debuts— **Cam** had the highest debut with “Burning House” landing at No. 57. **A Thousand Horses** had a nice start with “(This Ain’t No) Drunk Dial” coming in at No. 61. Also new to the chart are **Denny Strickland’s** “How Far You Wanna Go” at No. 76, **Corey Smith’s** “Feet Wet” at No. 78 and **Keith Walker’s** “Honky Tonk Shake” at No. 79

Liz Rose Receivēs Challenge Coin

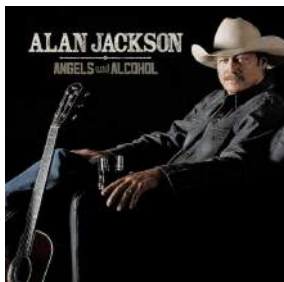

NO. 1 SONG

Promoted as “the ultimate love song,” **Eric Church**’s metaphor-filled “Like A Wrecking Ball” crashes through to the No. 1 song on *MusicRow*’s CountryBreakout Chart.

The hit was written by Church and **Casey Beathard** is featured on *The Outsiders*, one of the top selling country albums of 2014. The track is the third No. 1 single from that album, following “Give Me Back My Hometown” and “Talladega.”

Like the rest of Church’s albums, *The Outsiders* was produced by *MusicRow*’s 2015 Producer of The Year, **Jay Joyce**.

As Church continues to [break records](#) during [The Outsiders Tour](#), he will join **Kenny Chesney** for a few stadium tours this summer. He will also be the first act to perform at Nashville’s new Ascend Amphitheater. The solo-acoustic shows (July 30-31) are sold out.
