Top Ten- Eric Paslay made it to the Top Spot this week after 20 Weeks on the chart with "Song About A Girl." Tim McGraw spends another week at No. 2 with "Meanwhile, Back at Mama's." Lee Brice's "I Don't Dance" moves up one spot to No. 3. Dierks Bentley jumped two spots to No. 4 with "Drunk on A Plane" followed by The Swon Brothers' "Later On," which remained at No. 5. Lady Antebellum moved "Bartender" to No. 6 and Joe Nichols will remain at No. 7 another week. Brantley Gilbert moves into the Top 10 with "Small Town Throwdown" at No. 8 as does Chase Rice's "Ready, Set, Roll" coming in at No. 9. Finally, David Nail is in the Top 10 for the first time with "Kiss You Tonight."

Greatest Gainers- Florida Georgia Line made a big debut this week with their new song "Dirt." They had 763 spins in their first week. Kenny Chesney's "American Kids" had 534 additional spins and Luke Bryan had 431 more for "Roller Coaster." Justin Moore's cover of the Motley Crue classic "Home Sweet Home" gains 345. Miranda & Carrie continue to make gains with "Somethin' Bad" gaining 277 spins.

Debuts- **FGL** not only had the greatest gain, but the highest debut. "Dirt" enters the chart at No. 46. **Justin Moore** breaks in this week at 61 with "Home Sweet Home." **Ben Rue** makes the chart this week with "I Can't Wait (Be My Wife)" coming in at No. 75 and **Marianne Allison**'s "Till It Breaks My Heart" debuts at No. 80.



NO. 1 SONG

Radio stations were all about "A Song About a Girl" as it came in at the No. 1 spot on the *MusicRow*CountryBreakout Chart this week. The song was made famous by **Eric Paslay**, who co-wrote the title with **Jessi**



"About a Girl" is the second single off his debut album Eric Paslay, released on Feb. 4, and is his first single of his own that has graced the top of the MusicRow Chart. MusicRow's Robert K. Oermann said of the single: "I like this atmospheric-production. He's on a roll: the boy goes two for two," referring to his debut hit "Friday Night," which was produced by Marshall Altman and certified Gold in April. This isn't the first time Paslay has ascended our chart. He was a co-writer for Rascal Flatts' "Rewind," which took the top spot in April. You can catch Paslay perform both of these hits as he plays festivals and fairs throughout September in the Midwest and east coast.




What criteria and resources do you use to determine spins
