Artist Bio:

From the time he was a kid, Nick has always loved all kinds of music, but he especially loved singers with a deep base voice. Nick comes from a musical family, and when his mom, Inspirational Country singer/songwriter Cherie Brennan, heard him singing covers from country artists like Trace Adkins and Josh Turner, she asked him if he ever thought he'd like to do it for real.
