Garth Announces First Stop On World Tour

Garth Brooks is set to launch his comeback world tour at the Allstate Arena in Rosemont, Ill., on Thursday, Sept. 4. The show will also feature **Trisha Yearwood**. Tickets go on sale Friday, July 25 at 10 a.m. "As an entertainer, you get asked a lot 'What are the best cities to play?' Without hesitation, I rattle five or six of the best places to play and that list always includes Chicago. It is the perfect city to launch the World Tour!" said Brooks.



All tickets will cost \$56.94 plus \$2.56 tax plus \$6.00 service charges, totaling \$65.50. More information on the show and tickets can be found [HERE](#).

Top Ten — After two weeks at No. 2, **Tim McGraw's** "Meanwhile, Back at Mama's" finally makes the top of the Country Breakout Chart. **Lee Brice** is at No. 2 with "I Don't Dance" followed by **Dierks Bentley's** "Drunk On A Plane" at No. 3. **Lady Antebellum** gains two spots and moves "Bartender" to No. 4. **Swon Brothers** remain at No. 5 again this week with "Later On." **Kenny Chesney's** "American Kids" and the **Miranda & Carrie** duet "Somethin' Bad" both break into the Top Ten at No. 7 and No. 8, respectively. **Chase Rice** is at No. 9 again this week with "Ready Set Roll" and **David Nail** also remains at No. 10 with "Kiss You Tonight."

Greatest Gainers — **Florida Georgia Line** is the greatest gainer again this week with "Dirt" receiving 806 more spins this week. **Luke Bryan** is climbing the chart with "Roller Coaster" seeing 468 additional spins. **Kenny Chesney's** "American Kids" is also gaining more airplay with an increase of 427. **Little Big Town** saw a spin increase of 279 for "Day Drinking" and **Tim McGraw's** "Meanwhile, Back at Mama's" went up 272 spins to allow it to reach No. 1.

Debuts - **Chris Lane** had the highest debut this week with "Broken Windshield View" coming in at No. 70. Also making the chart for the first time are **Brett Eldredge's** "Mean To Me" at No. 74, **Veronica Ballestrini's** "Cookies & Cream" at No. 75, **Erica Sunshine Lee's** "Georgia For This" at No. 76, **Jana Kramer's** "Love" at No. 77, **Joey Hyde's** "Get It On" at No. 78 and **Phillip Claypool's** "Come On Back Home" at No. 80.

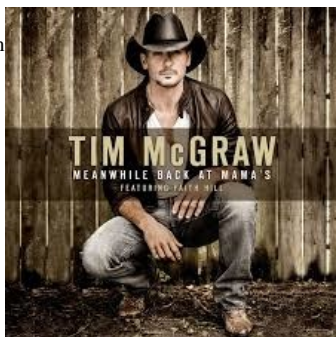


NO. 1 SONG

Seven-hundred and fifty three acres of Williamson County is where **Tim McGraw** took camera crews to film the [music video](#) for the latest No. 1 on the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout Chart, "Meanwhile Back at Mama's."

Tom Douglas, Jaren Johnston and **Jeffrey Steele** joined forces to

open the Big Machine single, which premiered 14 weeks ago at the 2014 ACM Awards. Footage from the ABC broadcast is infused into the music video.



Faith Hill joins her husband for the song and video, which additionally features the power couple's sprawling landscape. [Available for \\$20-million](#), four residences, a 12-stall barn, a caretakers apartment, a restored log home and a yet-to-be-restored antebellum home are settled on the rolling pastures and ponds. An appropriate setting to depict where the "for sale sign's gone up," but we would need more than a loan to own even three acres of their country estate.

McGraw has a heaving tour schedule through the summer. Hill's website currently lands on a page noting that a "New site coming soon." We'll look forward to hearing what she has in store.

Greg Almond WGGC/Bowling Green, KY

Tell us about your station and your market.

Bowling Green, KY is a GREAT market for Country music! Our accessibility to Nashville plays a huge part in that. A lot of times "new" music to us isn't new to them. Our listeners are also very loyal to those artists who play shows here. We pride ourselves on being the Live Music station in BG. In 2014 alone we will have had Love and Theft, David Nail and Jana Kramer.

What role do promoters play in your decision making?

I have and always will play the best songs that fit what we are trying to do musically. Promoters will introduce me to artists that might not normally be on my radar and they help me form and maintain relationships with labels and artists. For example, I may not ever have been exposed to an artist like Chris Weaver or Clare Dunn without their promoters.

What criteria do you use to add new music?

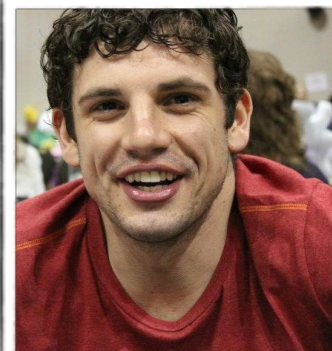
Is it a hit or does it sound like a hit? What else is there?

It gives us legitimacy and a connection to those labels and artists we want to form relationships with.

Who are some of the new artists that excite you?
