Top Ten— Kip Moore secures the No. 1 position this week with "I'm To Blame." Luke Bryan moves into the last step before the top with "Kick The Dust Up" at No. 2. Thomas Rhett leap frogs into the No. 3 position with "Crash And Burn." Lady Antebellum's "Long Stretch Of Love" remains at No. 4 followed by **Zac Brown Band's** "Loving You Easy" at No. 5. Chase Rice is back up two spots to No. 6 with "Gonna Wanna Tonight." Sam Hunt jumps three to No. 7 with "House Party." Maddie & Tae's "Fly" is up to No. 8 followed by Keith Urban's "John Cougar John Deere John 3:16." Urban's song breaks the top ten as does Chris Janson's "Buy Me A Boat" at No. 10.

Greatest Spin Gainers— Cam's "Burning House" is the top gainer for a second consecutive week, moving the spins up 345. **Kenny Chesney's** "Save It For A Rainy Day" bumps them up 283 and **Thomas Rhett's** "Crash And Burn" jumps two spots thanks to 259 new plays. Kelsea Ballerini's sophomore single "Dibs" saw spins increased by 251. Keith Urban's "John Cougar John Deere John 3:16" hits the top ten after 248 new spins.

Debuts— Jerrod Niemann had the highest debut this week with "Blue Bandana" landing at No. 70. Also new to the chart are Rainey Qualley's "Me And Johnny Cash" at No. 79 and David Nail's "Night's On Fire" at No. 80.

Tae and Canaan Smith.






