The **Swon Brothers** move up one to No. 4 with "Later On" followed by **Kenny Chesney's** "American Kids" at No. 5. **Brantley Gilbert** is at No. 6 again this week with "Small Town Throwdown" followed by last week's chart topper, "Meanwhile, Back At Mama's" by **Tim McGraw**, at No. 7. **Miranda Lambert & Carrie Underwood** remain at No. 8 another week with "Somethin' Bad" and **David Nail** jumps one spot to No. 9 with "Kiss You Tonight." Entering the top ten for the first time is **Chase Rice** "Ready Set Roll" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers— **Florida Georgia Line** is the greatest gainer for the third week in a row with 449 new spins for "Dirt." **Jason Aldean's** latest "Burnin' It Down" debuted with 433 plays in the first week. **Luke Bryan's** "Roller Coaster" continues to climb with 421 more spins. **Kenny Chesney** breaks into the Top 5 with "American Kids" played 289 more times. **Maddie & Tae's** "Girl In A Country Song" is on the chart this week with the song heard 288 more times than last.

Debuts— **Jason Aldean** had the highest debut with "Burnin' It Down" debuting at No. 60 in its first week. **Maddie & Tae** are on the chart for the first time at No. 69 with "Girl In A Country Song." And **Jerrod Niemann** is at No. 80 and officially moving up the chart with "Buzz Back Girl."

Dierks Bentley flew to the No. 1 on spot on *MusicRow's* CountryBreakout Chart this week with his single "Drunk on a Plane." Co-written by Bentley, **Josh Kear** and **Chris Tompkins**, this will be his second single to hit No. 1



on the *MusicRow* chart this year ("I Hold On" reached No. 1 on Jan. 30). "Drunk on a Plane" is the third single from his album *Riser*.

To raise money for **Monroe Carell Jr. Children's Hospital** at Vanderbilt, Bentley will be hosting his ninth annual *Miles and Music* concert Sept. 28 at the Riverfront Park in Nashville, following the motorcycle ride from Columbia, Tenn. Bub McCullough- WMCI- Mattoon, IL

Tell us about your station and your market.

WMCI will celebrate its 25th anniversary on August 24, 2014. We went on the air in 1989, and of course that year included newcomers like **Garth Brooks** and **Alan Jackson**. We're live and we're local and we give back to the community. Our biggest success story would be St.



Jude. In 13 years, our radio-thons and various side events have netted nearly \$1,000,000. When you consider we sit in a town of about 18,000 people, that's pretty huge.

What role do promoters play in your decision making?

I realize it's their job, but I also recognize the fact that their passion for the product is genuine. If not, they wouldn't be promoting songs and artists. I appreciate their input greatly, along with the fact that without them, some artists/songs would never be heard.

How long have you been at the station? What is your title?

August 17, 2014 will be my 25th anniversary. Program director, mornings, production director, copywriter and sales. Many hats.

What criteria do you use to add new music?

If it sounds like a hit, play it.

What does it mean, to you, to report on MusicRow.

It means they value what we're doing here in small town USA. And I love the fact that we play a big role in the success of our future stars.
