Top Ten— **Luke Bryan** had a meteoric 10 week climb to put "Kick The Dust Up" into the No. 1 position this week. **Thomas Rhett** moves "Crash And Burn" one spot to No. 2 followed by **Lady Antebellum** at No 3 with "Long Stretch of Love." **Zac Brown Band** is up to No. 4 with "Loving You Easy." **Chase Rice's** "Ready Set Roll" is still holding strong after 36 weeks, up one spot to No. 5. **Sam Hunt** is throwing a "House Party" at No. 6. **Maddie & Tae** are on the way up with "Fly" landing at No. 7. **Keith Urban's** "John Cougar John Deere John 3:16" is at No. 8 and **Chris Janson** sails to No. 9 with "Buy Me A Boat." Breaking the Top 10 this week is **Brett Eldredge's** "Lose My Mind" at No. 10.

Greatest Spin Gainers— **Blake Shelton's** new single "Gonna" had the highest spin gain with 482. **Jerrod Niemann's** "Blue Bandana" is a hit in its second week with 388 new plays followed by **Kenny Chesney's** "Save It For A Rainy Day" which increased 379. **Cam's** "Burning House" is on fire with 283 more spins this week. **Luke Bryan's** additional 282 plays for "Kick The Dust Up" landed it in the No. 1 spot this week.

Debuts—**Blake Shelton** had the highest debut this week with "Gonna" at No. 53. **Easton Corbin** jumped in at No. 66 with "Yup." Also new to the chart are **Lucy Angel's** "Crazy Too" at No. 78, **Ronnie Dunn's** "Ain't No Trucks In Texas" at No. 79, and **Sugarcane Jane** at No. 80 with "The Game."

NO. 1 SONG

It only took 10 short weeks to put **Luke Bryan** back into the No. 1 spot. His latest single, "Kick The Dust Up," is at the top of the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout Chart this week. It's the lead single from his upcoming album, *Kill The Lights*, which is due out on Aug. 7.



The song was written by three familiar names to the Luke Bryan single library. **Chris DeStefano**, **Dallas Davidson**, and **Ashely Gorley**. The trio also wrote Bryan's mega-hit "That's My Kind Of Night." In addition, this is DeStefano's third No. 1 of 2015. Gorley and Davidson both penned the recent **Jason Aldean** chart topper, "Tonight Looks Good On You," and are also responsible for Bryan's 2014 smash, "Play It Again."
