Top Ten— Lee Brice is the No. 1 Song this week on the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout Chart with "I Don't Dance" after 24 weeks. Lady Antebellum has moved closer to that spot, coming in at No. 2 with "Bartender." Swon Brothers continue their climb as "Later On" comes in at No. 3. Kenny Chesney's latest single "American Kids" is at No. 4 followed by Brantley Gilbert's "Small Town Throwdown" at No. 5. Miranda Lambert & Carrie Underwood jump two spots with "Somethin' Bad" landing at No. 6, followed by last week's No. 1 "Drunk On A Plane" by Dierks Bentley at No. 7. Eric Church's "Cold One" is at No. 8 and David Nail is at No. 9 again this week with "Kiss You Tonight." Chase Rice remains at No. 10 another week with "Ready Set Roll."

Greatest Gainers— Jason Aldean's "Burnin' It Down" is the biggest gainer this week with 596 more plays than last week, moving it from No. 61 to No. 35. Luke Bryan saw 408 new spins this week for "Roller Coaster." Florida Georgia Line continues to gain traction with 373 additional plays for "Dirt." Kenny Chesney had 228 new plays for "American Kids" and Sam Hunt's new song "Leave The Night On" gained 209 more spins.

Debuts— **Thomas Rhett** had the highest debut this week with "Make Me Wanna" at No. 78. **RaeLynn's** "God Made Girls" is on the chart for the first time at No. 79. **Ariana Hodes** broke into the Breakout Chart this week at No. 80 with "Brand New Key."

Although he confesses he's not a dancer, Lee Brice has proved he is able to muster enough moves to shake himself all the way up the MusicRow CountryBreakout Chart, again. The Curb recording artist has claimed this week's No. 1 spot on the CountryBreakout Chart with "I Don't Dance."



It's taken 24 weeks for the

Curb Records title track to take it's place atop the chart, preluding Brice's third album release on Sept. 9. Co-written by the Curb recording artist with Dallas Davidson and Rob Hatch, the single was penned for the first dance at his wedding. At an exclusive listening party hosted by Robert K. Oermann, Brice noted, "We finished writing the song and I immediately told Rob and Dallas, 'Guys, this is the one."

Brice has been working out his producing chops lately, having produced various tracks on his first two Curb releases and 100 percent of I Don't Dance. He is also noted as a producer on Curb duo American Young and new coming trio, Sister C.

I listen to what music they have that I might have missed but I make the decision on what is added.

In what areas does your station excel? (this is where you can do some bragging!)

We try to get our listeners to give their opinion to new music and they do like to give their opinion. Our listeners like to use us as a sounding board especially on shows like the CMA awards and other shows. If they hear new artists or new music, they call and I try to listen to everything they say and program accordingly.
