

Thomas Rhett's sophomore album, <u>Tangled Up</u>, won't be released until Sept. 25, but it's already off to a great start. The lead single, "Crash And Burn," is No. 1 on the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout chart this week.

"Crash And Burn" shows that Rhett's next album will be full of songs that were influenced



The hit was written by Jesse Frasure and Chris Stapleton. Frasure has a No. 1 song this year with Florida Georgia Line's "Sun Daze," and Stapleton also earned a MusicRow Challenge Coin for writing Luke Bryan's "Drink A Beer," which went No. 1 in early 2014. Rhett hit the top of the chart in January of this year with "Make Me Wanna."


