This is the 3rd No. 1 for Hunt as an artist and the 4th as a writer. He also co-wrote "Cop Car" for **Keith Urban** which hit No. 1 in early 2014.

This is the third No. 1 as a writer for Crowell, and his second as a producer.

Flowers will receive his first No. 1 Challenge Coin as a writer for "House Party."

Hunt is currently out with **Lady Antebellum** and **Hunter Hayes** for the *Wheels Up* tour and was recently added to **Luke Bryan's** <u>Crash My Playa</u> event in Riviera Maya, Mexico which will happen in January 2016.


