Top Ten— Kenny Chesney's "American Kids" is the No. 1 song on the Country Breakout Chart this week. The Swon Brothers gain one spot and move "Later On" to No. 2 followed by Brantley Gilbert's "Small Town Throwdown." Last week's No. 1 "Bartender" by Lady Antebellum fell to No. 4. Florida Georgia Line jumped two spots to No. 5 with "Dirt." Miranda Lambert and Carrie Underwood fell one spot to No. 6 with "Somethin' Bad," followed by Eric Church, who also fell one to No. 7 with "Cold One." Luke Bryan's "Roller Coaster" is in the top 10 for the first time. Chase Rice remains at No. 9 again this week with "Ready Set Roll" and David Nail falls two spots to No. 10 with "Kiss You Tonight."

Greatest Gainers— Jason Aldean had the biggest gain for the second week in a row. "Burnin' It Down" had 356 additional spins this week. Maddie & Tae had "Girl In A Country Song" played 337 more times with Luke Bryan close behind with 317 additional spins for "Roller Coaster." Thomas Rhett had a nice increase with 287 more plays and Florida Georgia Line's "Dirt" moved two spots on the chart thanks to 271 more spins this week.

**Debuts**— **Chris Young** was the highest debut this week with "Lonely Eyes" coming in at No. 74. Also new to the chart this week are **SaraBeth**'s "Nowhere With You" at No. 77 and **Dylan Scott**'s "Mmm, Mmm, Mmm" at No. 79.

# Kenny Chesney, Kenny Chesney! He's at No. 1 this week on the CountryBreakout Chart with the first single from his forthcoming album, titled "American Kids." The Blue Chair-Columbia single was written by a trio of hit makers, Rodney Clawson, Luke Laird, and Shane McAnally. Sales for the



single have already passed Gold status in advance of his September 23rd album release.

Although Chesney will not tour this year, except for one free Flora-Bama-Jama concert on August 16, the Country mainstay has prepared the 11-track album to tide fans over. Again co-produced with longtime producer **Buddy**Cannon, Chesney has named the album *The Big Revival* and plans to feature guest vocals from Alison Krauss, Dan Tyminski, and Grace Potter.

We'll have to see if any surprise guests pop onto the stage in Orange Beach, Fl. Who has their wristband?


