Meet country newcomer Peyton Davis, whose sparkling debut single, "Nowhere America," is impacting radio now. Raised in the Midwest and Florida, and currently a senior at the University of Texas at Austin, Peyton was attracted to the song's small town storyline and timeless country themes.

"This song just paints a picture of the things that are so American," said Peyton. "In that sense, I found it to be patriotic. I loved what it was about, I could relate to it and knew that I wanted to record it."

Peyton has visited more than 50 stations on her GrassRoots radio promo tour, which resumes Aug. 22 in Texas. "Nowhere America" is from her recently released nine-song album, *Country Road*, produced by Julian Sundby.




