Top Ten— After 30 weeks on the CountryBreakout Chart, **The Swon Brothers** have hit No. 1 with "Later On." **Florida Georgia Line** jumped three spots to No. 2 with "Dirt," followed by **Brantley Gilbert's "Small Town Throwdown" which is at No. 3** another week. Luke Bryan moves up four spots to No. 4 with "Roller Coaster." Miranda Lambert and Carrie Underwood are at No. 5 with "Somethin' Bad" and Eric Church is at No. 6 with "Cold One." Last week's top song "American Kids" by Kenny **Chesney** drops to No. 7, followed by **Chase Rice** at No. 8 with "Ready Set Roll." **Cole Swindell** is now in the Top 10 with "Hope You Get Lonely Tonight" at No. 9. **Dustin Lynch** is also making his first appearance in the top 10 with "Where It's At" coming in at No. 10.




