Top Ten— Florida Georgia Line is at No. 1 after only eight weeks on the chart with "Dirt." Brantley Gilbert is up one to No. 2 with "Small Town Throwdown," followed by "Roller Coaster" by Luke Bryan at No. 3 and "Somethin' Bad" by Miranda Lambert & Carrie Underwood at No. 4. Eric Church is now in the Top 5 with "Cold One" landing at No. 5. Cole Swindell jumped three spots to No. 6 with "Hope You Get Lonely Tonight." Chase Rice continues his climb with "Ready Set Roll" at No. 7 followed by Dustin Lynch's "Where It's At" at No. 8. David Nail is in the Top 10 for the first time with "Kiss You Tonight" at No. 9, and Little Big Town also make it there with "Day Drinking" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers—Blake Shelton had the highest gain this week with "Neon Lights" up 716 spins. Maddie & Tae moved up the chart to No. 23 with the help of 286 new plays of "Girl In A Country Song." Darius Rucker's "Homegrown Honey" broke into the chart with 285 plays. Brad Paisley's "Perfect Storm" had 268 spins in its first week. The 268 new spins for Florida Georgia Line's "Dirt" helped it reach No. 1 this week.

Debuts— Darius Rucker's "Homegrown Honey" is the highest debut this week at No. 59. **Leah Turner** makes the chart at No. 68 with "My Finger." Also new to the CountryBreakout Chart is **Brad Paisley**'s "Perfect Storm" at No. 75, **Presley & Taylor**'s "Kickin' Back" at No. 76, **Lee Ann Womack** at No. 77 with "The Way I'm Livin," and **Kelleigh Bannen** at No. 78 with "You Are What You Love."


