Landing at No. 6 is **Cole Swindell's** "Hope You Get Lonely Tonight," followed by **Chase Rice** and "Ready Set Roll" at No. 7. **Little Big Town** moves two spots to No. 8 with "Day Drinking" and **Dustin Lynch** drops one to No. 9 with "Where It's At." **David Nail** falls to No. 10 this week with "Kiss You Tonight."

**Greatest Gainers**— **Garth Brooks** was the top spin gainer this week with "People Loving People" gaining 742 spins in the first week. **Blake Shelton's** "Neon Lights" was up five spots on the chart thanks to 389 more spins this week. **Brad Paisley's** "Perfect Storm" was played 338 more times. **Jason Aldean** was up 255 spins with "Burnin' It Down" while **Darius Rucker** saw "HomeGrown Honey" gather 236 more plays this week.

## NO. 1 SONG

At the end of a summer full of drinking on planes, tailgates on riverbanks, bartending, beachin', whiskey and water, **Florida Georgia Line** has turned the tide to nurse our hangovers with their first ballad, "Dirt." The Republic Nashville single hits the No. 1 spot for the second week in a row on the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout Chart.



It's quite a party on 16th Avenue for the companies that control the duo as both songwriters, **Rodney Clawson** and **Chris Tompkins**, also pen songs for the company. Ironically, this marks the fourth No. 1 in five weeks that Clawson has contributed writing credits after writing about letting loose ("American Kids," Aug. 14, "Bartender," August 7, "Dirt," August 28).

In the spirit of the current single, Florida Georgia line has launched the Dirt Campaign, with a goal to raise \$100,000 with Omaze and WarpSpeed to benefit Habitat for Humanity. ## Voices Of Independent Promotions

Mark Maynard/CEO/Momentum Music/Nashville, TN

### How did you get into radio promotions?

In the 80's, working at MCA Nashville I did Sales/marketing and worked closely with **Shelia Shipley** who was VP of National Promotions. It was fascinating to watch her and her promotion team deliver the hits. Years later I worked with **Mike Borchetta** at an Independent label where he taught me a lot. Barbara Kelly took the time to teach me all the specifics on how things worked in Country radio. Barbara is retired now but was an amazing radio promoter and a really wonderful person.



### What is your favorite thing about your work?

Watching the artist I work with hear themselves on radio for the first time... A beautiful moment.

### What is best about working with stations on the MusicRow Panel?

Getting to work with and coming to know a lot of radio personalities and the radio promoters. Plus MusicRow panel is so much more receptive to new artists and new music.

### Tell us about one of your proudest accomplishments?

**Fletch Brown** at WXFL calling me up one day and telling me he's going to add a single I was working. And he wanted me to know it was my call that convinced him to listen and consider it. It was my first call where I felt responsible for getting the add. I can't thank Fletch enough for that moment.

### What is an interesting fact that others may not know about you?

I use to manage **Alan Woody**, bass player for **Gov't Mule** and the **Allman Brothers** Band. In the early 90's I hooked him up with a writer named **John Jaworowicz** and they wrote a song called "End Of The Line" for the Allman Brothers. It became a Top 5 AOR hit for the Brothers, their first charted hit since "Ramblin Man" in the 70's. I gave John a ride to Alan's house and wish I had stuck around that afternoon and wrote with them...
