Miranda Lambert & Carrie Underwood's "Somethin' Bad" is also up one to No. 3. Eric Church moves "Cold One" to No. 4 with Little Big Town right behind at No. 5 with "Day Drinking." Cole Swindell's "Hope You Get Lonely Tonight" is at No. 6 again this week followed by Chase Rice who spends another week at No. 7 with "Ready Set Roll." Last week's No. 1 "Dirt" by Florida Georgia Line is at No. 8 and Jason Aldean breaks the Top Ten with "Burnin' It Down" at No. 9. Keith Urban also reaches the top 10 with "Somewhere In My Car" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers— Garth Brooks is the biggest gainer again this week with "People Loving People" up 639 spins. Brad Paisley's "Perfect Storm" is up to No. 38 this week after 385 new spins. Blake Shelton's "Neon Light" had 350 new spins to bring it to No. 15. Tim McGraw's "Shotgun Rider" moved up 9 spots after 246 more plays this week. And Trisha Yearwood broke into the chart in her third week with "PrizeFighter" gaining 237 more spins.

**Debuts— Easton Corbin** was the highest debut with "Baby Be My Love Song" at No. 73. **Trisha Yearwood** also made her debut at No. 74 with "PrizeFighter." Also new to the chart is **Rick Monroe**'s "Fires Out" at No. 77, **Matt Williams** w/ **Alyssa Morrisey** and "Make Love Tonight" at No. 78, **Mitch Goudy** and "Ain't My Fault" is at No. 79 and **Tyler Barham** came in at No. 80 with "More Than A Cotton Dress."


