Luke Bryan's "Strip It Down" leaps five spots and is at No. 5 followed by Jake Owen's "Real Life" at No. 6. Cam's "Burning House" is up to No.7 while Darius Rucker remains at No. 8 with "Southern Style." Carrie Underwood is not going to take a break while moving "Smoke Break" up the chart. The songs jumps from No. 17 to No. 10.

Greatest Spin Gainers—Brad Paisley's "Country Nation" had the highest spin gain this week with 381. Luke Bryan moves five spots with 371 new plays for "Strip It Down."

Carrie Underwood continues a quick climb with "Smoke Break" gaining 360. The Band Perry's "Live Forever" receives 245 more spins while Tim McGraw moves into the Top 20 thanks to an spin increase of 223 for "Top 0f The World."

After their debut, platinum-selling single, "Girl In A Country Song" hit No. 1, broke records and secured award nominations, their sophomore single "Fly" has now become their second consecutive chart topper. The hit song takes the No. 1 spot this week on



MusicRow's CountryBreakout Chart.

Written by the duo's **Maddie Marlow** and **Taylor Dye** along with **Tiffany Vartanyan**, "Fly" certainly shows contrast to "Girl In A Country Song." It is meant to be an empowering and motivating anthem, and it has connected well with radio and its listeners.

Maddie & Tae's debut album off Dot Records, *Start Here*, peaked at No. 2 on the country album chart when it was released last month.

They travelled on the road this past summer as a part of **Dierks Bentley's** *Sounds Of Summer Tour* and will wrap that up this weekend. M&T will kick off their own <u>headlining tour</u> October 7 in New York City.

Maddie & Tae are nominated for three CMA Awards this year including Duo of the Year, New Artist of the Year, and Video of the Year. The awards will be held November 4 in Nashville.


