## Dierks Bentley Celebrates 10 Years As Grand Ole Opry Member

**Dierks Bentley** celebrated his 10th anniversary as a member

of the Grand Ole Opry this week. During his set, Bentley performed hits including "What Was I Thinkin," "Settle For A Slowdown," "Free And Easy (Down The Road I Go)," "Home," and "Riser." He was also joined by friends **Dailey and Vincent** for the bluegrass tune "Rovin' Gambler," and his dog Jake, who was also there during his Opry induction 10 years ago.

Brett Eldredge drops one spot to No. 3 with "Lose My Mind." Cam's "Burning House" steps up one spot to No. 4. Carrie Underwood jumps "Smoke Break" to No. 5 followed by Brothers Osborne at No. 6 with "Stay A Little Longer." Blake Shelton's "Gonna" is up three to No. 7 and Dierks Bentley cracks the Top 10 with "Riser" at No. 8 Darius Rucker falls one spot to No. 9 with "Southern Style." Cole Swindell also moves into the Top 10 with "Let Me See Ya Girl" at No. 10

Greatest Spin Gainers— George Strait was the top gainer this week with his new song "Cold Beer Conversation" gaining 429 spins this week. Thomas Rhett's "Die A Happy Man" brought in 412 new plays and Sam Hunt's "Break Up In A Small Town" up 365. Brad Paisley saw "Country Nation" up 364 plays and Kelsea Ballerini called "Dibs" on 281 additional spins.

**Debuts— Thomas Rhett** had the top debut with "Die A Happy Man" at No. 54. **George Strait** was close behind at No. 55 with "Cold Beer Conversation." **Zac Brown Band** debuts at No. 71 with "Beautiful Drug." **Joe Nichols'** "Freaks Like Me" shows up at No. 75. Also new to chart are **Josh Goodlett's** "Why You Gotta Be That Way" at No. 77 and **Granger Smith's** "Backroad Song" at No. 78.

## NO. 1 SONG

Was **Luke Bryan** just at the top of our *MusicRow*CountryBreakout Chart? Oh yeah, two months ago with "Kick The Dust Up." Well deserved for the Capitol Nashville superstar as he takes "Strip It Down" to this week's peak position with the help of not only his label team, but his co-writer team.



Ross Copperman and Jon Nite co-penned "Strip It Down" with Bryan. Nite's songwriting has

previously visited the No. 1 spot with **A Thousand Horses'** "Smoke" while Copperman helped co-pen that BMLG single in addition to two other top titles this year, "John Cougar John Deere John 3:16" (**Keith Urban**) and "Don't It" (**Billy Currington**).

Of the single, Bryan says, "I've never really done like that slow dance, take your girl and have a big ol' night of romance and all that, and 'Strip...' kind of does that and I'm interested to see how the fans react. I don't think three years ago I could have delivered a song like 'Strip..' like I wanted to, but it felt right the way we wrote it...Ross and Jon came [to my house], and we knocked out."

"Strip It Down" is the second single from Bryan's full-length 2015 album, *Kill The Lights*, which has sold over 580,000 copies. This week's No. 1 single has moved nearly 350,000 units of its own.

Catch Bryan on Sunday, November 1, at the CMHoF discussing his career and performing a short acoustic set in support of his *Luke Bryan: Dirt Road Diary* exhibition. On the road, Bryan just kicked off his 7th annual *Farm Tour* in Fort Wayne, In., but was forced to postpone night two in Lexington, Ky., to October 6 due to weather. After he's done farmin', his *Kick The Dust Up Tour* will resume in 2016, when the country superstar heads to Mexico for his annual *Crash My Playa* event, co-hosted by **Cole Swindell.**


